



Getting to Bangkok: Airport and Transportation Guide





Bangkok is served by two airports: Suvarnabhumi (BKK) and Don Mueang (DMK). Both offer convenient connections to the city and InterContinental Bangkok Ratchaprasong. To make your journey smooth, here's a quick guide to the city's two airports and transportation options.

Suvarnabhumi Airport (BKK)





Bangkok's main international gateway

-  Location: ~30 km east of downtown
-  Best for: International flights

Getting into the city:

-  Airport Rail Link (ARL): 5:30-24:00 at the basement (B-Level), fast train to Phaya Thai BTS, ~30 minutes, THB 15–45
-  Taxis: 24/7 at the Arrivals Hall (Level 1), metered fare + THB 50 surcharge
-  AOT Limousine: Premium transfers, bookable at counters or app
-  Buses & Vans: Routes to Khaosan Road, Bang Sue, Rangsit, plus intercity buses to Pattaya, Hua Hin, and more



Getting to InterContinental Bangkok Ratchaprasong:

-  Airport Rail Link (ARL):
 - Board at Suvarnabhumi → Phaya Thai (~30 min, THB 45)
 - Transfer to BTS Sukhumvit Line → Chit Lom station (~10 min)
 - Hotel is directly connected via skywalk
-  Taxi:
 - 28–30 km, ~23–40 min depending on traffic
 - Fare: THB 240–300 + THB 50 airport surcharge + tolls
-  Private Transfer / Limousine:
 - Door-to-door comfort, ~30 min
 - Book via AOT Limousine or hotel concierge
-  Public Bus/Van:
 - Cheapest option (THB 20–40), but ~90 min and requires transfers.

Don Mueang Airport (DMK)





Bangkok's domestic and budget airline hub

-  Location: ~24 km north of downtown
-  Best for: AirAsia, Nok Air, Lion Air

Getting into the city:

-  SRT Red Line Train: Direct to Bang Sue MRT, ~30 minutes
-  Airport Buses (BMTA):
 - A1: Mo Chit BTS/MRT
 - A2: Victory Monument BTS
 - A3: Lumpini Park
 - A4: Khao San Road
-  Taxis & Ride-Hailing: Metered fare + THB 50 surcharge; Grab available
-  Car Rental: Available in both terminals

Getting to InterContinental Bangkok Ratchaprasong:

-  SRT Red Line Train:
 - Board at Don Mueang → Bang Sue MRT (~30 min)
 - Transfer to MRT Blue Line → Sukhumvit → BTS Asok → BTS Chit Lom (~30 min)
-  Airport Buses (BMTA):
 - A1: Mo Chit BTS → BTS Chit Lom (~40–50 min)
 - A2: Victory Monument BTS → BTS Chit Lom (~40 min)
-  Taxi / Grab:
 - 24 km, ~30–50 min depending on traffic
 - Fare: THB 200–350 + THB 50 surcharge.
-  Car Rental:
 - Available at DMK, ~40 min drive to hotel

Shuttle Between Airports

- Free shuttle bus for transit passengers
- 🕒 Hours: 5 AM – midnight, every 30 minutes
- 🕒 Travel time: 60–90 minutes
- 📍 Boarding points:
 - Suvarnabhumi: Level 2, Gate 3
 - Don Mueang: Level 4, Gate 5
